

Northern Escape Heli-Skiing

Skeena Spey Private Package Travel Information

Our Base of operations is Terrace, BC, a 90 min flight north of Vancouver, BC. For your convenience, book your flights directly to/from Terrace, BC via Vancouver, BC. Please book your flights early between Vancouver and Terrace as they can sell out quickly.

The Northern Escape Private Lodge is a fly in lodge, but does have road access. Transfers to and from the lodge are customized specifically with each group. Heli Flights into and out of the Private Lodge are weather and daylight dependent. During poor weather, or when outside daylight hours, alternate ground transfers may be arranged.

Arrivals:

- Our office will work with your schedule to customize your arrival and transfer plan. Heli Transfers from the Terrace Airport are offered, daylight dependent. For later arrivals a road transfer is available.

Departures:

- Our office will work with your schedule to customize your departure and transfer plan. Heli Transfers from the Terrace Airport are offered, daylight dependent. For later departures a road transfer is available.

Please contact our office to make all arrangements.

Private Package – Packing List Guidelines

As the transfer to the Lodge and back is via helicopter, we have strict weight restrictions which must be adhered to.

- Soft sided duffel bags only. Avoid bags with wheels or rigid frames.
- Maximum bag size is 30 x 24 x 16 inches / 100 litres, 22.5 KG (50 Lbs) max
- You are encouraged to use our powder skis and snowboards.
- **Carry Ski and Snowboard boots separately and as carry-on luggage**
- Excess baggage that results in additional flight time will be charged a minimum of \$500 per guest or you may be asked to repack your belongings to meet the weight restriction

Suggested Packing List:

- **Ski or Snowboard Boots – Packed in Carry-On Luggage**
- Goggles
- Sunglasses
- 1-2 pairs of gloves or mitts (one light, one warm)
- Ski or Snowboard Helmet
- Waterproof Ski/Snowboard Pants
- Waterproof Ski/Snowboard Jacket
- Insulated Jacket (ie. Down or Primaloft)
- Warm Fleece or lightly insulated layer
- Neck Tube
- Toque or Beanie
- Merino Wool Baselayer (Top)
- Merino Wool Baselayer (Bottom)
- Merino Wool Ski or Snowboard Socks
- Winter Boots or Rubber Boots (for transfer days)

- Casual clothing and shoes
- Bathing Suit for Hot Tub and Sauna
