

2024 Elite Package Travel Information Northern Escape Heli-Skiing

Travel Information

The first day of your package is a transfer day. The last day of your package is a ski day with departure after skiing. A Northern Escape Heli-Skiing representative will meet at the Terrace Regional Airport at the following times to prepare you for your helicopter transfer to the Mountain Lodge. **Please note that you must arrange your arrival in Terrace with sufficient time for flight and weather delays to meet your Heli connection on time. The Helicopter transfer is weather and daylight dependent.**

You will be met by a Northern Escape team member at the times noted below for transfer to the helicopter and departure to the Mountain Lodge.

Meeting Times at Terrace Airport:

- All Trips between Dec 1st and April 30th – Meet at 10:00
 - o Recommended flight – AC8437 arriving Terrace @ 09:39

Departure Times from the Northern Escape Mountain Lodge:

- All Trips between Dec 1st and April 30th – Depart approx. 13:30
 - o Recommended flight – AC8444 departing Terrace @ 15:50

****Please Note – Due to the remote fly in/out nature of the lodge, we cannot accommodate alternate arrivals or departures beyond that which is described here. We highly recommend you consider Trip Interruption Insurance to cover the costs that could be associated with the unlikely possibility of a commercial flight delay or cancelation causing you to miss the scheduled flight into the lodge. Additional flight cost is \$3,600 CAD/ hour.**

Elite Package – Packing List Guidelines

As the transfer to the Lodge and back is via helicopter, we have strict weight restrictions which must be adhered to.

- Soft sided duffel bags only. Avoid bags with wheels or rigid frames.
- Maximum bag size is 30 x 24 x 16 inches / 100 litres, 22.5 KG (50 Lbs) max
- Carry Ski and Snowboard boots separately and as carry-on luggage
- You are encouraged to use our powder skis and snowboards.
- Excess baggage that results in additional flight time will be charged a minimum of \$500 per guest or you may be asked to repack your belongings to meet the weight restriction

Suggested Packing List:

- Ski or Snowboard Boots
- Goggles
- Sunglasses
- 1-2 pairs of gloves or mitts (one light, one warm)
- Ski or Snowboard Helmet
- Waterproof Ski/Snowboard Pants
- Waterproof Ski/Snowboard Jacket
- Insulated Jacket (ie. Down or Primaloft)
- Warm Fleece or lightly insulated layer
- Neck Tube
- Toque or Beanie
- Merino Wool Baselayer (Top)
- Merino Wool Baselayer (Bottom)
- Merino Wool Ski or Snowboard Socks
- Winter Boots or Rubber Boots (for transfer days)

AT THE LODGE

- Casual clothing and indoor lodge shoes/slippers
- Bathing Suit for Hot Tub and Sauna
